

## Specification of the Main Hunter Organ (B C Shepherd and Sons 1995 –)

3-manual instrument installed in St Andrew's Church in 1960 (Hunter, 1927, incorporating pipework from an organ by Bishop, 1881). Electric action and enlargement between 1977 and 1979. EP to Choir and electric slide solenoids to Swell and Great fitted in 1995. Pedal stops are on unit chests so switching is via the solid state unit. Tab Console.
