Security Policy

All who visit our parish churches for worship, prayer or enquiry are welcome. We have a responsibility towards our congregations and all who visit. The parish therefore expects all visitors to behave tolerantly and acceptably. Any who do not behave acceptably will be asked to leave and, under appropriate circumstances if they do not comply they do not comply, the Metropolitan Police will be asked to attend.

All who visit either church outside worship hours should take reasonable precautions to ensure their own safety. Measures should include the carrying of a mobile phone, the avoidance of direct contact with anyone unknown or who may be acting abnormally. All incidents involving known members of the public who are under police monitoring must be recorded in the police diary — kept in the clergy vestry in each church — and should be notified promptly to a church warden.
